## What is CHAMPS?

"CHAMPS is designed to help the classroom teacher develop an effective classroom management plan that is proactive, positive, and instructional." -Randy Sprick, Ph.D.

The CHAMPS approach prepares teachers to create the optimal classroom environment so that all students may be successful.

## **CHAMPS is:**

- a model, or guide for *all* teachers.
- a "toolbox" of strategies.
- focused on creating a
- positive and respectful learning environment.

## **CHAMPS is NOT:**

- a behavior management program for students.
- a one-size-fits all plan to follow.
- intended for new teachers only.

## What does a CHAMPS classroom look like?

The instructor may demonstrate any or all of the following:

- greets students at the door;
- has effective beginning and ending routines;
- communicates and posts clear
- expectations for instructional activities;
- provides frequent, specific feedback;
- uses an Attention Signal effectively;

- uses proximity to decrease opportunity for misbehavior;
- provides brief, business-like corrections;
- provides positive interaction to students soon after behavior corrections; and
- consistently models friendly and respectful interactions.
