### Student Rewards

Looking to motivate and reward your students for a job well done? Don't rely on complicated systems or pricy treasure box fillers! Consider intermittently surprising students with one of these simple (and wallet-friendly!) rewards.

- Badges, buttons and stickers
- Certificate of improvement
- Seating preference
- Applause
- Eat with the teacher(s)
- Paper crowns
- Notes/phone calls home
- Student job preference
- Academic games
- Popcorn, etc.
- Listen to music
- Class theme for the day
- Work outside
- Redecorate classroom
- Tell a joke
- Show & Tell
- Special pencils and pens
- Invite parents to class
- Invite principal to class

Remember to rotate the type of reward you provide. Some of your students will be highly motivated by tangibles and food, while others might prefer recognition, competition, or even "free-time." It can be helpful to include this type of question on a student survey or questionnaire at the beginning of the year.
