### **Domain 2: Classroom Environment**

### 2a: Creating an Environment of Respect and Rapport

- Ratio of interactions (3:1)
- Teacher and students interactions are uniformly respectful
- Contingent and non-contingent attention utilized

### 2b: Establishing a Culture for Learning

- Expectations for learning and achievement
  - CHAMPS, MAC, ACHIEVE acronym

### 2c: Managing Classroom Procedures

- Attention signal utilized effectively
- Effective beginning routines
- Effective ending routines
- Transitions are effectively managed, timely, and smooth
- Help procedures explained/evident (bathroom, sharpen pencil etc.)
- Movement expectations communicated
- Student assignments/materials efficiently managed

### 2d: Managing Student Behavior

- Evidence of rules taught
- Compliance expected and monitored
- Monitoring of behavior is subtle and preventative
- Feedback provided to students
- Teacher scans and circulates throughout classroom
- Positive feedback appropriately utilized
- Both positive and corrective feedback used to shape individual student behavior
- A variety of mild in class consequences are utilized
- Corrective consequences are consistently enforced
- Effective corrective feedback (clear statements, avoids overuse of warnings)
- Pre-correction and mild in-class consequences utilized
- Behavior corrected fluently without interrupting flow of instruction
